

## What is Autism Spectrum Disorder -

Autism falls under a spectrum of disorders, and is believed to have a range of neuro-developmental disorders of which the symptoms can occur in any combination and varying degrees of severity. Generally characteristics are; extreme aloneness, isolation from their environment, insistence on sameness, disordered personality, speech delays, ritualistic behaviours and impaired relationships. According to research, it is estimated that 21-100% of children diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) display a number of notable motor deficits. This makes it all the more essential for children with ASD to have some form of gross motor therapeutic intervention. Gross motor developmental difficulties can be seen when a baby learns to crawl already, and then subsequently leading to walking and other vital motor developments.
